STAGE DOOR DROP OFF AND PICK UP:

- All dancers must enter & exit through the stage door entrance to the theater, located on the west side of the building, around the corner from the Box Office. Dancers need to enter and leave the theater in street clothes. Parents will not be able to go to dressing rooms.
- All dancers must sign in and out with Security at the stage door entrance.
- All dancers will remain in dressing rooms until called downstairs by Security, where they will sign out and be released to parents/guardians at the stage door.
- Dancers who are in Act I but are not in Act II may be picked up during intermission or at the end of the performance.
- If your child is unable to attend a dress rehearsal or performance due to illness or an emergency, please call Becky Moore's cell phone 925-437-2929.

THEATER ETIQUETTE:

- **Reminder:** It is the policy of the Marin Veterans' Memorial Auditorium that absolutely **no** video or photographic equipment is permitted at any rehearsal or performance.
- **Reminder:** All *Nutcracker* rehearsals, at Marin Ballet studios and at the theater, are closed for observation. Only performers and volunteers will be allowed in the studio/theater unless prior consent is obtained.
- **Ticket Reminder:** All audience members must have a ticket. Performers who wish to sit in the audience for a performance of the alternate cast or Act I dancers who wish to watch Act II must have a ticket for that performance. Act II dancers will **not** be able to watch Act I of the same performance.
- Dancers will not be permitted to watch from the wings, as backstage space is extremely limited.

MAKEUP & DANCE BAG CHECKLIST:

- **Dance Bag Checklist:** All dancers need to be sure that they bring the following items with them each time they attend a *Nutcracker* Tech/Dress rehearsal or performance. **Primary & Intermediate Division dancers need to have a single satchel or duffel-type bag that is able to hold all of their belongings.** Please put your child's name on their belongings (especially tights and dance shoes). Dancers should always have their class uniform with them.

- **Intermediate & Advanced Ballet Division Makeup:** These students (Levels 5-9) need to assemble their own makeup kit. Please review the information below regarding the items needed in the stage makeup kit. With proper care, this makeup kit should last for many years and will be used for all Marin Ballet productions.

Kryolan is our preferred makeup choice because it costs less, stays on longer, and has a very long shelf life. D'Lynnes Dancewear in San Rafael has agreed to offer Marin Ballet Intermediate & Advanced Division students a 10% discount on the Kryolan items listed below. We have listed these items in order of importance for the makeup kits.

Foundation: Kryolan's Aqua Color or oil free foundation: select a shade slightly darker than your skin color.
(makeup sponge to apply foundation)

Setting Powder: Kryolan or any other translucent loose powder.

Mascara: Waterproof in black or black/brown

Eye Liner: In black. Physician's Formula eye definer felt tip eye marker (available at most Drug Stores) or Kryolan.

Eye Shadow and Highlighting: Kryolan: Light color – "Highlight" and Dark color – #101

Eyebrows: Kryolan's eyebrow pencil in light, medium or dark

Rouge: Kryolan's "Youth Red" for all except darker skin tones who may use "081"

Lips: For Russian: Kryolan lip color "LC102." For All Others: Kryolan lip colors "Natural 2" or "Natural 3."

Recommended Kryolan Brushes: Eye shadow - #1734, Eye liner - #4200, Blush - #1709, Lip - #4204

NO NUTS AT NUTCRACKER!:

It has come to our attention that several of our *Nutcracker* dancers have severe nut allergies.

For this reason, we ask that there are no nuts, or food containing nuts, in *Nutcracker* rehearsals or at the theater.

THEATER ATTIRE:

Marin Ballet provides the costumes for our productions. However, personal items such as tights, briefs/trunks and shoes are the responsibility of each performer. If you are unable to purchase any of the items required for your child's role, please contact Tracy Kirst ASAP at marinballetwardrobe@yahoo.com. Marin Ballet has a limited number of trunks and black shoes that can be loaned out. Please carefully review the information below regarding the items required for each role.

SHOES:

- **For some characters, special shoes are required** (please look below for your child's role). If black shoes are required, your child may continue to wear them in classes after *Nutcracker* so you may get your full value for them.
- **All students must bring their performance shoes, sewn, broken in and labeled with their name and role to the studio dress rehearsals on December 5 & 6.**
- All shoes need to be clean and in good condition and must have thin elastics.

TIGHTS:

- Dancers need to have a clean pair of tights as well as a spare pair for each performance they are in.
- Dancers performing in two performances in one day should have a pair of tights for each performance to avoid "baggy knees". Tights get dirty in the theater very quickly and accidents do happen, so it is a good idea to have a spare pair of performance tights.
- Level 5-9 dancers must wear Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights.

HAIR:

- Dancers need to supply their own bobby pins to secure hair/headpieces, elastics that match hair color & hair nets for buns. Dancers should have hairspray or hair gel.

COSTUMES:

- Upon arrival at the theater, dancers need to check to see that their costume is hanging in its place with all accessories.
- **Students may not eat, drink or sit while in costume.**
- At the end of each dress rehearsal and performance all dancers are responsible for making sure that the costume they use is returned to its original hanger, with all accessories returned to the baggies, which are attached to the hanger.

SPACING UNIFORM:

- All students must wear pink tights and their class uniform for spacing rehearsals. Pink leg-warmers and pink fitted ballet sweaters will be the only warm-up apparel allowed.

COSTUME ACCESSORIES YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE: *all students also need to bring their complete class uniform to all rehearsals and performances, as they will not be in costume for the entire rehearsal/performance time frame.*

ACT I

Party Girls & Clara: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in ringlets. Ringlets should be purchased at D'Lynnes Dancewear. Clara needs pink trunks in addition to everything above.

Party Boys & Fritz: **Black ballet shoes with pink elastics**, class uniform, hair in a low bun.

Nutcracker: White unitard, white ballet shoes.

Mouse King: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, shoes to be provided by Marin Ballet.

Mice (Level 5): Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, pink leather ballet slippers with single pink elastic, hair in high bun.

Soldiers (Level 5): Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, **black ballet shoes with pink elastics**, class leotard and close-fitting white t-shirt under costume, hair in a very high, flat bun on top of head.

Snow Corps, Demis, Queen: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, pink trunks, pointe shoes, hair in high bun.

ACT II

Spanish: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, pointe shoes, pink trunks, and hair in a bun

Arabian: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, pointe shoes, pink trunks, and hair in a bun.

Chinese Corps: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, **black ballet shoes with pink elastic**, hair in high, flat bun.

Chinese Soloist and Demis: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights **black pointe shoes** with pink ribbon and elastic.

Goose: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, pointe shoes, pink trunks, and hair in a bun.

Russian Baker Corps and Demis: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, pink ballet shoes, class leotard, hair in bun.

Flours & Sugar Plum: Danskin #71 Ballet Pink seamed tights, pointe shoes, pink trunks, and hair in a bun.

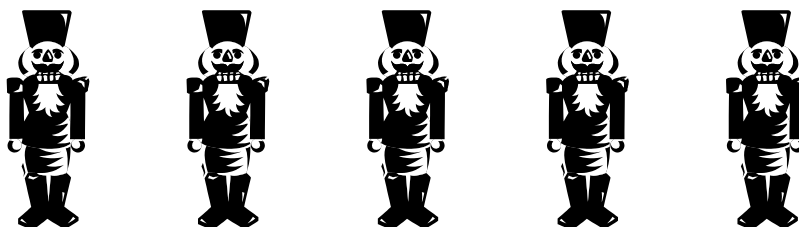

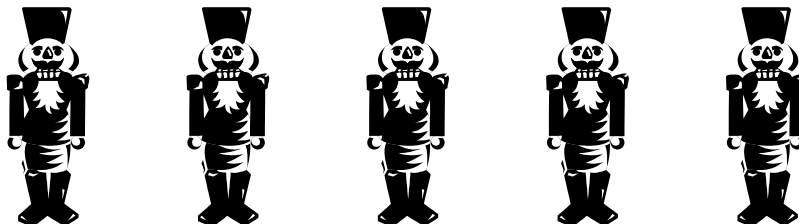
